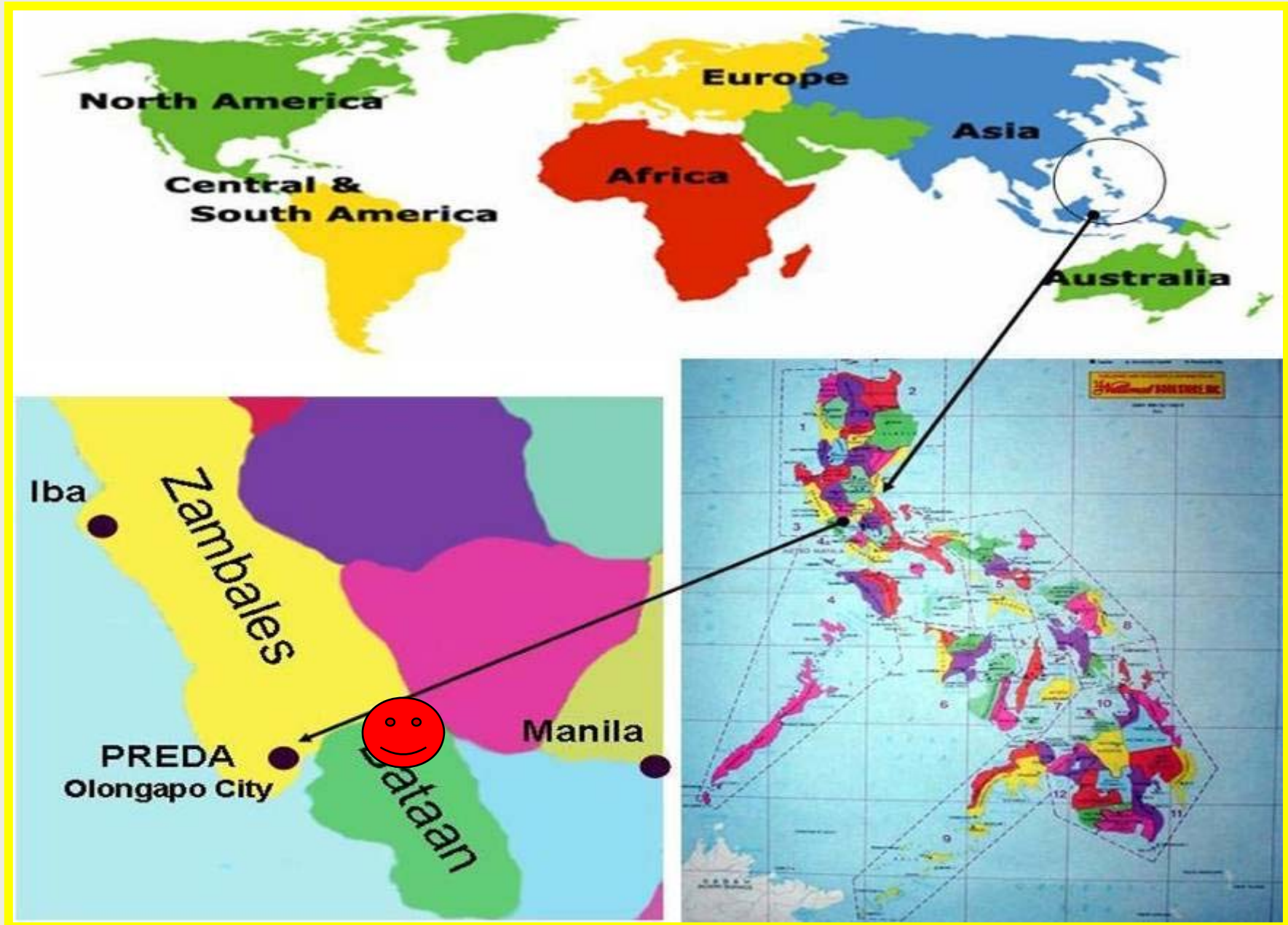
CHILD SEX TRAFFICKING IN THE PHILIPPINES

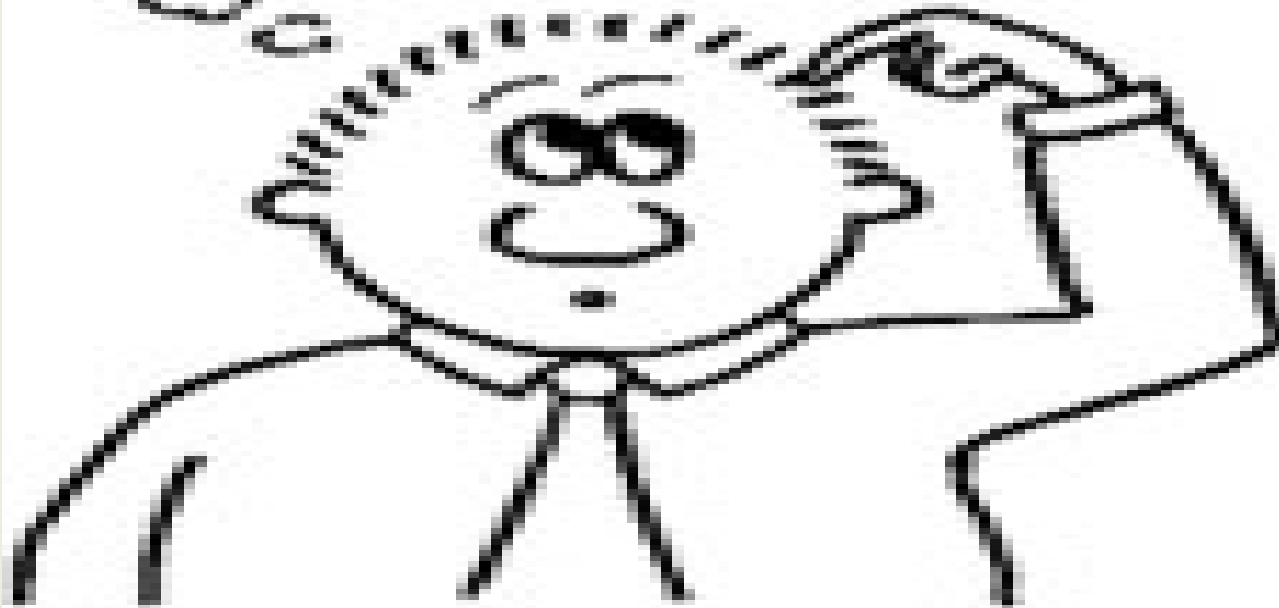

- come from large and poverty-stricken families in remote rural areas (e.g., Samar, Leyte in the Visayas; Zamboanga, General Santos in Mindanao);
- normally brought to urban centers such as Metro Manila and on to other countries like Japan, US, Europe, East Malaysia, Australia, New Zealand, Taiwan, Province of China, China (ECPAT & Asia ACTS, 2003)

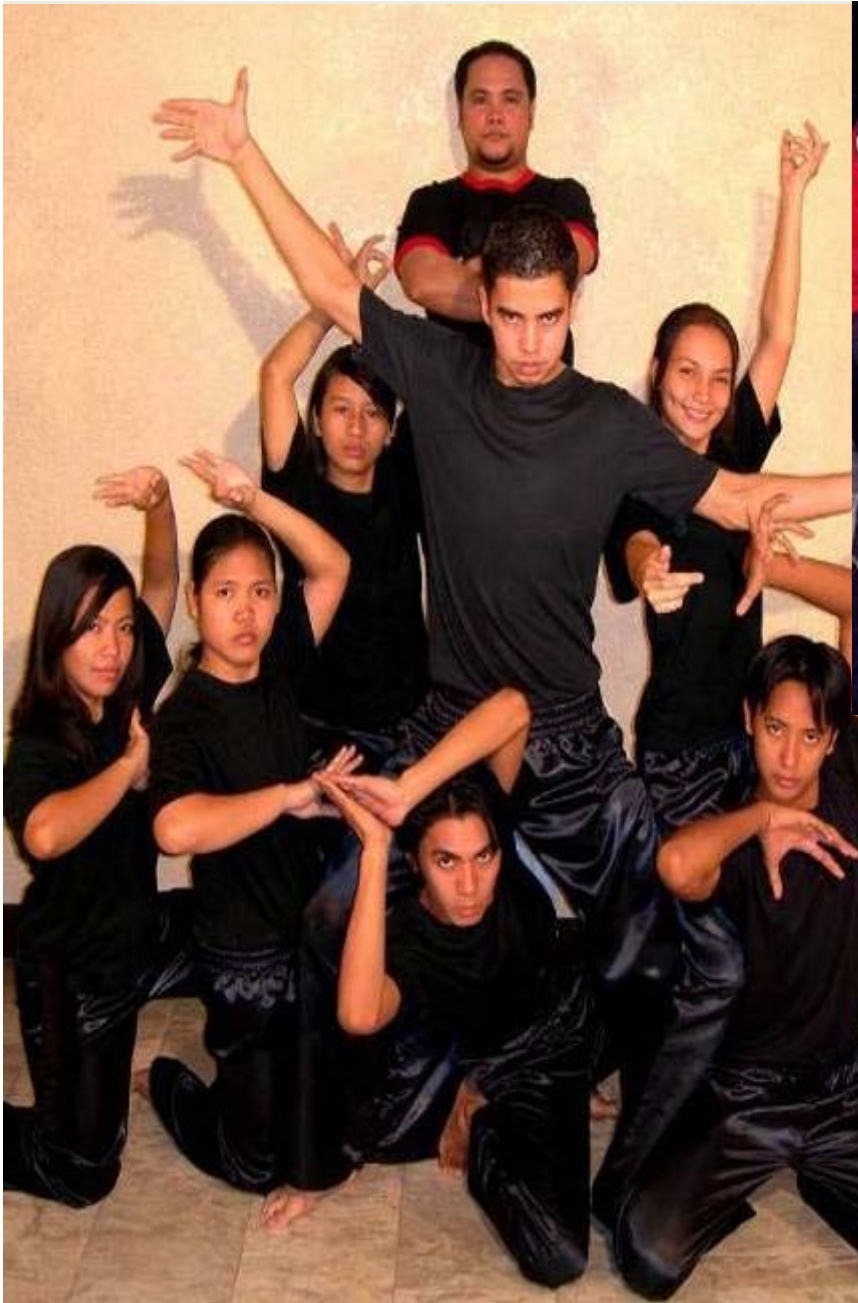
Public Education and Preventive Seminars (PEPS)



- Provides specialised integrated workshop and trainings through the provinces to elementary and high school students, teachers, social workers and community and church leaders for the prevention of child abuse, drug abuse and the HIV-AIDS by using hand-outs posters, video showing, puppetry and direct people participation.
